128th Air Refueling Wing



We started our tour through the massive cargo door. Otherwise, there is an open hatch below the cockpit where the crew can climb up a ladder. Once inside, there's seating for about 40 troops (80 max). There's not much interior space because below our feet are the fuel tanks for its aerial refueling customers. In the back is the position the boom operator lays and controls the boom, complete with chin rest. And finally up front in the cockpit shows the many instrument displays.
